1. Each school may enter one (1) student in Keyboarding I, two (2) students in Keyboarding II, and two (2) students in Bookkeeping/Accounting. Keyboarding I, students may be from the 9th-12th grade. Keyboarding II contestants must be juniors or seniors and Bookkeeping/Accounting contestants must be juniors or seniors.
2. A contestant may enter only one contest.
3. A participant will be considered late after 8:45 a.m. Late arrivals cannot participate.
4. A scholarship will be awarded to those 1st place winners who are seniors and who plan to enroll in the Business Education Department at Wallace Community College in Selma. **Please specify on the entry form whether the student plans to compete for a scholarship to the Business Education Department.**
5. Entries will be accepted by **email (ONLY)**. Please send to the ACE Registration Clerk at (ace@wccs.edu). The deadline is Friday, February 21, 2020. A confirmation will follow receipt.
6. The Bookkeeping/Accounting Contest is open only to students currently enrolled in your Bookkeeping/Accounting class. Those who have completed Bookkeeping/Accounting are not eligible to compete. The student should supply his/her own calculator.
7. The Keyboarding I Contest is open to students currently enrolled in your Keyboarding I class.
8. Those who have completed Keyboarding I should enter the Keyboarding II Contest.
9. **THERE WILL BE NO SUBSTITUTION OF PARTICIPANTS AFTER THE FEBRUARY 21st DEADLINE.**
